Dear Poster Session Participants,

The Gas-Cooled Reactor Fuels and Methods Program Reviews will be here before you know it, and we would like to provide you with some information to help you prepare. Thank you for indicating interest in participating in the poster session being held in conjunction with the program reviews.

The poster session will be held Wednesday, May 9, from 11:30 am to 1:00 pm during the lunch break. It is your responsibility to have your posters printed. We will have card board backing and supplies for mounting your posters. Posters can be set up any time on Wednesday morning before 11:00 am in Rooms A111, A112, and A113 which will be opened up into one large space.

Below are the items that will be available for your use:

- Easel
- Rigid cardboard backing 36" X 48" (Can be displayed either portrait or landscape)
- Binder clips or clear shipping tape to attach the poster to the backing.

During the poster session, please stand next to your poster so you are available to discuss it with the attendees.

If your travel arrangements allow it, we would like to leave your posters up during the High Temperature Reactor Symposium on Thursday, May 10. Please remove your poster no later than 5 p.m. on Thursday. Posters which have not been removed will be thrown away as we clean up at the end of the day.

If you plan to display more than one poster, please contact me as soon as possible at diana.russell@inl.gov to let me know how many posters you are planning on so we have adequate easels and backing boards.
